



Eu Yan Sang Integrative Health serves nutritious lunches to the elderly through 'Meals on Wheels'

SINGAPORE, 3 Oct 2012 – Eu Yan Sang Integrative Health (EYSIH), a wholly-owned subsidiary of listed Eu Yan Sang International Limited (EYS), steps up on its pledge to care for mankind by sponsoring wholesome lunches for the elderly under the care of its adopted charity organisation, Thye Hua Kwan Moral Society (THK), as part of EYSIH 10th Anniversary charity campaign.

This initiative, named 'Meals on Wheels', sees participation from more than 70 EYSIH's physicians, clinical assistants, staff and management today at THK Home Help Service East to prepare, pack and deliver food to 140 elderly, on top of spending quality time with them. 'Meals on Wheels' aims to benefit frail elderly who are part of the THK Home Help Service East.

EYSIH is the first organisation to reach out to THK Home Help Service East to offer endto-end assistance – from extending help in the kitchen to delivering food and providing the ingredients that goes into two special dishes created for the elderly.

Physicians of EYSIH looked into health profiles of the 140 frail elderly and carefully selected Chinese herbs to go with the special dishes: Stir-fry white fungus with pork tenderloin and seasonal vegetables with lily and wolfberries.

Chinese herbs used in the nutritious dishes were white fungus (strengthen kidneys), American ginseng (invigorate the spleen and lungs), red dates (tonify Qi and blood), dried lily bulbs (soothe and calm the mind), and Chinese wolfberries (promote vitality and brighten the eyes).

Commenting on EYSIH participation in 'Meals on Wheels', Group CEO of EYS Richard Eu said: "Beyond business goals, EYS and its subsidiaries also hold social goals close to our hearts. Over the years, we have actively engaged in the local community to do more good. We have always strived for a holistic wellness through the body, mind and spirit. And, what better way to plant seeds of wellness than to nourish the community through traditional Chinese herbs."

"Our knowledge and resources in TCM allows us to formulate healthy menus using quality herbs. We may consider extending such support in the future with other charity organisations, if this works out well," he added.

"Eu Yan Sang, Mr Richard Eu and more than 70 staff are setting a precedent for a local multinational company to link-up and bond with our needy elderly. Bravo!" said Lee Kim Siang, Chairman of THK.





Over the past few months, EYSIH have been actively raising funds for THK through donation boxes at EYS clinics across Singapore. An additional 10% of the total sum collected from the donation boxes during the six-month donation drive would be donated to THK. The other charity programmes included 'Bring-Your-Own –Bag', which started in July to encourage customers to bring their own bags for herbal medication or donate S\$1 for the bags and the sale of commemorative THK-EYS umbrellas at EYSIH clinics. These umbrellas are available at any EYS TCM clinics for S\$10 each from August onwards and all proceeds go to THK.
